Join us Friday, June 3rd at 2PM in dining room "C."

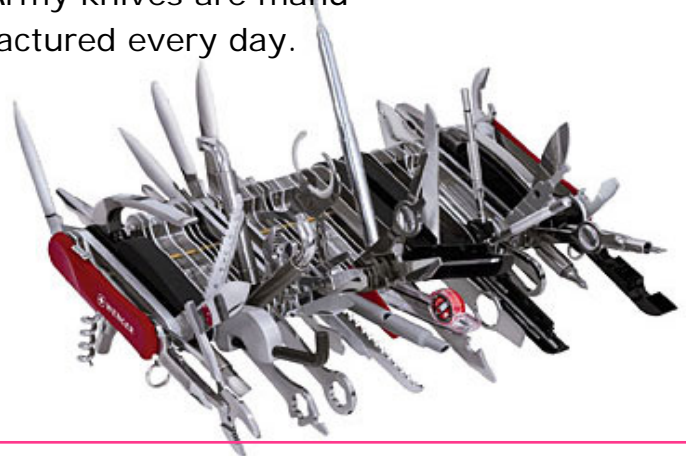
June 12, 1897: The Swiss Army

Karl Elsener legally registers his "soldiers' knife" for use by the Swiss army. The original -- made with a wooden handle -- included a blade, a screwdriver and a can opener. The classic Swiss army knife bears the Swiss national symbol, a white cross in the center of a red shield, outlined in white against the red handle. More than 34,000 Swiss Army knives are manufactured every day.

Spring Training for Major League Baseball



There are 15 major league teams playing Arizona spring training baseball at 10 diverse stadiums in eight different AZ cities & one Native American community.

In 2011 there was an addition of a new ballpark to the Cactus League's Phoenix area baseball spring training locations.

In July 2009, AZ Diamondbacks & Colorado Rockies announced they would leave Tucson to share a new spring training stadium east of Phoenix on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community. The first to be built on an Indian Nation.

The joint move of the Rockies & Diamondbacks means that all Cactus League baseball spring training locations are now in the greater Phoenix area.

All spring training baseball sites & teams:



Glendale Stadium: Dodgers and White Sox

This ballpark is the largest with 13,500 seats, 14 practice fields & a 2 acre lake.

Goodyear Ballpark: Cleveland Indians and Cincinnati Reds

This \$108 million stadium has 10,000 seats, ample parking & public art.



Hohokam Stadium: Chicago Cubs

Cactus League's only organist.

Maryvale Baseball Park: Milwaukee Brewers

56 acre complex holds 8,000 seats, sausage costumed mascots, Milwaukee beer & their "secret sauce."

Peoria Sports Complex: Seattle Mariners and San Diego Padres

The first spring training to host two teams.



Phoenix Municipal Stadium: Oakland A's

Family friendly with grassy picnic area, shaded seating & good selection of microbrewed beers.

Scottsdale Stadium: The Giants

Most upscale spring training experience with a "see & be seen" crowd, happy hour atmosphere & diverse food & drink.

Surprise Stadium: Kansas City Royals and Texas Rangers

Family friendly stadium with grassy lawn seating, merry-go-round & free parking.



Tempe Diablo Stadium: LA Angels of Anaheim

Centrally located, comfortable & spacious. Known for great hot dogs & scenic views of the Tempe Buttes.



Salt River Fields at Talking Stick: Diamondbacks & Rockies

Set on the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community east of Phoenix, making them the first MLB teams to have a spring training site on Native American Lands.
